BIBLE STORY

Matthew 4:1-4 Jesus in the desert

Note

Talk about how Pancake Day in the UK is also known as Shrove Tuesday and it is traditionally a day of fun and feasting before the 40 days of Lent start on Ash Wednesday.

There are 40 days in Lent to prepare for Easter because Jesus went to the desert for 40 days to prepare for his ministry.

Lent is a time of preparation for celebrating Easter, just as Advent helps us prepare to celebrate Christmas.

You can also talk about the food we eat at special times and why we eat pancakes.

CRAFT IDEAS

- Paint pancakes using food colouring or softened jams and spreads.
- Bring pancakes for families to eat with a variety of toppings for them to try.
- Make cardboard cut-out frying pans and pancakes and have fun trying pancake races.
