## GOD HAS A JOB FOR LITTLE OL' ME!

### 1 Samuel 16 The Anointing of David

Here are some ideas and activities you could do on your own



### Play

Dress up as a king or queen. What would your royal name be? What new rules would you make for your country?



### Create

Cut a person shape out of card. On one side design the person to look like yourself. Then turn the person over, and on the other side write things that are good about you, thinking especially about positive character traits (the things on the inside!). You can use this as a reminder that God doesn't just see the 'outside' of us - what we look like and the things that we are good at doing - but God sees what is in our hearts: our feelings and thoughts. You could design one of these for each member of your family or for your friends too!



### Draw

Draw a picture on white card using a white wax crayon. This will be very tricky to see. Then use some paint to paint over the card, and this will reveal your picture. You could write a secret message for someone to remind them that God always sees how beautiful we are on the inside!



### Investigate

What does a shepherd do? Search online for pictures of a shepherd. Is this a job that you would like? Why or why not?



### Watch
