Here are some ideas and activities you could do as a family

Pray

Sit together as a family and each think of a person or situation you would like to pray for. Sometimes we don't need words to pray, so this activity uses bubbles. Pass the bottle of bubbles around and ask each person to blow some bubbles as they think quietly about the person or situation they are praying for.

Investigate

Make a list or a spider diagram of famous people who have changed the world by going against what society says is normal (for example, Greta Thunberg, William Wilberforce, Malala Yousafzai, Anne Frank, Louis Braille). There are also examples of young people who are not as famous but who have still made a profound difference.



Create

Make some scrolls together. See https://missionbibleclass.org/2012/11/30/say-it-with-a-scroll/ Write out any of the Scriptures from this session on the scroll, or you could write encouraging letters to friends or family members.



Serve

Can you find some opportunities to spend 10 or 15 minutes serving your church or community together? This could be litter-picking the area outside, picking up leaves outside the hall, praying for situations in the local area or wider world, making biscuits to serve the congregation.
