Luke 10:25-37 The Good Samaritan

Here are some ideas and activities you could do as a family

Investigate

There is an organisation/charity called The Samaritans. Find out what they do and why you think it is called The Samaritans.

Play

Learn how to do some basic first aid together, such as how to clean and bandage a small cut or treat a bruise or a burn. Practise treating each other's imaginary injuries.

Share

Transform an old shoebox or gift bag into a gift for someone. Put tissue paper in the box and find or purchase food items like cans of soup and packets of tea to place in the box. Decorate the outside of the box and create a small card to tape to the box's lid. Deliver the gift to the person you have chosen.



Watch

Try the experiment together that you watched during the session, using a paper towel and a mug of water. You can find all the instructions here.

Why not talk about how there are lots of people in the world in need of love and how God wants us to share the love he gave us with others.



Create

Use some paint to create some handprints on paper. When the paint has dried, talk together about people you know that you could help (even if you don't want to or don't even like the person). Write names on each finger of your handprints. Explain that all of these people are our neighbours. In the palm of the hand, you can write the names of all the people who have helped you. Create a display of the hands or make a large flower with them on the floor or wall.
