Share

Do something for someone else: cook a meal and take it to a family in need; donate some of your pocket money; use a talent or skill God has given you to make someone happy.

3º Create

Take photos at times or places you feel close to God. Use an app or print your photos to make a collage of these special times. Think about how you can make time for more of those opportunities.

Have you got a magnet somewhere in your house? Try asking a family member to find one for you. Do you know how magnets work? You could do some research to find out. Magnets attract some metals. Do an investigation to find out which metals are attracted by the magnet. As you do, think about the times you feel pulled closer to God? God is always with us but sometimes we can feel closer to God than others. Share what you find with someone else in your family.
