Here are some ideas and activities you could do as a family

This week bring your family together to talk together about the different ways God wants us to live out our faith.

Read

The Bible: Why is it so important? What questions do you have about the Bible?
Talk about how you use the Bible in your family.
The Bible is full of what God has to say about life's big questions. Could your family read a book from the Bible together over the next couple of weeks and explore what God is saying to you all.

Cre

God's love isn't for the few, it is for everyone. How does your family share Jesus with others? Write down all the best things about loving Jesus and create an invitation to give to someone you want to invite along to something at your church. What could they join in with online?

Share

Can we be Christians on our own? Ask each other that question and look in the Bible to see what God has to say. Think about someone you haven't seen in a while. How could you reconnect?

Bake

Prepare a meal together. Food is so important. What are the favourite meals of people in your family? How often do you sit and eat together? Is it a happy and special time?

Jesus sat down and shared food so many times with his friends in the Bible. Think about how you can make your family meal times special.

Pray

How does your family pray? Do you have a favourite way to pray? Is it a family habit to share regularly with God together? Talk about creative ways you can pray together. Here is an idea you could try when you are all together. Ping Pong Prayer - As a family, take it in turns to say 'thank you God for ...' 'and for ...' and for ...' and see how long you can keep it going.

Hear

Jesus showed his disciples a model for serving others, but he also showed how important it is to be served and receive from others. Think about who has served you. How did you show them gratitude? What did you learn from them? Think about how you can serve others. What are the needs of those around you?
