



PUTTING GOD FIRST

Luke 10:38-42 Jesus visits Martha and Mary

Here are some ideas and activities you could do as a family

If you have a kite at home, take it to a local park on a windy day and fly it together. Or you could build your own! Talk about how the kite helps you see the effect of the wind and feel its power even though you

This is a lot like how you can see the effect of belief in Jesus in the world and feel his power, even though we can't see him. Ask Jesus to help you notice him more in the world, and to remind you to put him first in everything!

Bake

can't see the wind directly.

Make some biscuits together. But before you bake, mark each one with a cross by pressing lightly on to the top with a knife. Every time you enjoy one over the next week, tell God something you're grateful to him for.

Investigate

Get a Bible and turn to Luke's Gospel.
Flick through it and write a list of all the different places where Jesus met up with people. For example, by a lake, up a tree (Zacchaeus), up a mountain, in a graveyard... See how big you can make your list!

Act

Play a game of Charades, taking it in turns to act out and guess the things that are important to you (but sometimes distract you from Jesus).

Perform

Take it in turns to give a short performance - perhaps sing a song or say the alphabet backwards, or recite a times table. Everyone else is to try and distract them!
