# Explore

Look at The Salvation Army YouTube channel and watch some of the films on a variety of social action projects that The Salvation Army is involved in around the world.



#### Share

Find out about your local foodbank.
What stocks are they running low on
right now? Can your family donate some food
or other items? Maybe you could ask other
families, or your school, to get involved too.



# Investigate

Look together at <u>The Salvation Army's</u> International Development website.

Choose a campaign that touches your heart and get stuck in, helping those people in desperate need in other parts of the world.



### Hear

Talk together about what you are passionate about. Is there something that you know is happening in your community that isn't right? Who are the people or what are the places that need help? Work together to think about how your family could make a difference. Who will you tell? How will you tell them?



#### Watch

Watch '<u>The Starfish Story</u>' together. Chat together about how in the parable one small boy made a difference.



## Memorise

Challenge your family to memorise the following Scripture.

Speak up for those who cannot speak for themselves.

Defend the rights of all those who have nothing.

Speak up and judge fairly.

Defend the rights of the poor and needy. Proverbs 31:8-9 (ICB)
