Here are some ideas and activities you could do on your own

Build

Make a telephone out of Styrofoam or paper cups. Poke a hole in the bottom of each cup and connect them with a string or ribbon. Secure the string inside the cup with a knot and tape. Decorate the cups with crayons or stickers. When the string is tight you can use it to talk to a member of your family and listen really well to what the person says to you. Try it out with different lengths of string. At what length can you hear the other person most clearly? Think about how Samuel had to listen hard to hear what God was saying to him.

Create

Create a wordsearch using some of the words from the United Nations Convention of the Rights of the Child. Print out some copies and ask your friends or family members to complete it. Try http://wordsearchcreator.co.uk if you need some help.

Pray

Show your family how to draw little faces on your fingers and use it pray for children that you know or for children in other countries.

Play

Play a game of Chinese Whispers with your friends or family. You will have to listen really carefully to the message to ensure that it gets passed on correctly!



Draw

Make a poster for World Children's Day on 20 November. Can you include some of the Rights of the Child on your poster? Where can you display your poster?
