HOW CAN I SHARE JOY WITH MY FAMILY THIS CHRISTMAS?

Matthew 1:18-25 Joseph accepts Jesus as his son



Build

Mary and Joseph went on a long journey to Bethlehem. As we begin the countdown to Christmas, use some building blocks or junk modelling to build a 'road to Bethlehem'. Each day move Mary and Joseph a little closer to Bethlehem. As they travel, each day getting closer to the birth of Jesus, think what his birth meant to them and what it means for us.
