Here are some ideas and activities you could do on your own

Create

Make a treasure map. Think of a place where you and your family like to visit. Make a map of it and decide where you will hide some treasure next time you visit. You'll also need to decide what the treasure is. Get your family to have a go at finding the treasure.

Write

Last week, we suggested you could try keep a journal and write or draw how you are feeling. Use a space in your journal to record the names of those you trust who you can share your feelings with. Share

Try building another tower, but instead of writing down the things which can take our focus away from God, write down the things which build up your relationship with God. Watch
