Cree

A heart image is often used to represent love. Gather some stones and make a large outline of a heart on the ground. Now use the heart for whatever you want – you could make it a race track, a collection area for your favourite objects, or just a place to sit in while you sing or read.

Make

Make a scrap book or photo album of family members and friends you love and who love you. Use your album to remind yourself that there are lots of people who care for you. No matter how many people we love, there is always more love in our hearts.

Learn
