■ Matthew 10:1-16 Jesus sends out the Twelve

Here are some ideas and activities you could do on your own

Write

Take some time to imagine you are sitting in a room with God and write down the questions you would like to ask. Write down these questions, perhaps using sticky notes, pieces of paper, string and pegs, a large sheet of paper or any other way you choose.

Then ask other people in your house the questions they would like to ask and add them to your list. When you feel ready, share these questions with your family or your church leader and ask them to help you explore what God might be saying.

Hear

Do you enjoy listening to music? Maybe you have a favourite band, artist or song. Take this week to try something new: try a new radio station, try a recommended artist on the list, or ask your adult for a recommendation.

Draw

Reread the Bible passage Matthew 10:1-16. Have a go at drawing what you think the scene would look like. Focus on the faces of the disciples and what their reactions might have been.

Share

Do you remember the packing game? What did you put in your bag or suitcase? Use them as a reminder to help you share God's love in your family, school, community.

Investigate

Search for 'Chartres labyrinth' online.
Labyrinths are different from mazes. Do
you know why? Use your finger to trace a path
and see if you can tell the difference. As you
journey to the middle, let your thoughts wander
and see what you think about. Pause in the
middle and then journey back out.
