KS2 Short Lesson Plan Guide for Teachers

LESSON OBJECTIVES

- To learn about the work of The Salvation Army during the pandemic.
- To consider why The Salvation Army helps people.

STARTER

Slide 1 - Tell me ...

- *One fun thing you've done lately ...*
- *One thing you've learned lately ...*
- *One thing that is really easy for you to do ...*
- *One kind thing you've done recently ...*
- *One thing you really miss ...*

Sum up and highlight how we are all adapting.

MAIN LESSON

Slide 2 - Learning objectives

Slide 3 - Previous knowledge

What do you know about The Salvation Army?

Key points:

1. Christian church: members believe in God, learn from the Bible and follow Jesus.
2. Charity: to help to improve people's lives. Salvation Army members and volunteers work together to help others.

SALVATION ARMY CHARITY

Slide 4 - Activity

Use resource sheet A.

In pairs or small groups do: **Guess the word** or **Act out**.

Can you guess the key word in bold?

Online groups: Look for clues on slide 5.

Slide 5 - More info

Expand on what the pupils have worked out.

3. employment/training
4. counselling/support/debt/money
5. families/clubs/family tracing
6. adults/clubs/older people/care homes

8. emergency

DURING THE PANDEMIC

Slide 6 - Video(s)

How is The Salvation Army helping people during the pandemic?

Watford: *What else was in the food parcels? Why do you think a letter and craft materials are also in the food parcels?*

Homeless: *How much has the need increased by? How were people greeted? What else is being given as well as food and drink? Why is respect, love and attention important?*

NHS: *Why was The Salvation Army asked to help? Why do you think the NHS is being helped? What impact might this have?*



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Slide 7 and 8 - More info

Emergency support; campaigns; food parcels; buildings; toy appeal.

Visiting; international; online support; online worship; virtual church.

Slide 9 - Local area

The Salvation Army in the local area.

SALVATION ARMY CHURCH

Slide 10 - But why?

Why does The Salvation Army do all this work? Why do they help people?

Discuss with talk partner, then feed back.

Slide 11 - Following Jesus

Explain link between Jesus' teaching - showing love to each other and the work of The Salvation Army.

Click to reveal sentence.

Question if 'work' is the correct word.

Click to reveal amended sentence.

Could it be 'mission/passion or joy'?

Helping others is a way to show that Jesus loves you.

Point out one important activity not highlighted. Ask for ideas. (Clue jiggle ears.)

LISTEN, RESPECT, LOVE

Slide 12 - Listening ear

Explain purpose of 'listening ear': time, relationship, respect.

Slide 13 - Examples

How were people being treated with respect in the video(s)?

Or explain 'safe space' for a chat at the emergency vehicle.

Or watch **Droitwich supporting older people** video.

Slide 14 - Questions/Discussion

Share the learning objectives. Any questions?

Or ask:

I wonder ...

- *What might be the easiest thing [for The Salvation Army] to do?*
- *What might be the hardest thing to do?*
- *What is the most important thing The Salvation Army does?*
- *What has the biggest impact?*

(Slides six and seven may help.)

Slide 15 - Activity

Use **resource sheet B**.

PLENARY

Slide 16 - Hot-seating

Hot-seating - based on imaginary person or inspired by photos. Whole class, then progress to smaller groups (optional). What might be the impact from all this help?

Slide 17 - Follow-up activity

Use **resource sheet C**. *How important do you think each activity is?*

Online groups: Create a word collage.
