



EASTER SUNDAY

Matthew 28:1-10 Jesus has risen

Each child will need:

- → A hollow chocolate Easter egg
- → Eggs to juggle (real, plastic or chocolate!) optional see Game 4, Start It section
- → Pens/pencils and paper

- → A photo of an Easter egg hunt in your room optional see Game 2, Start it section

Start It

Today is a day of celebration. Let's party and play some games!

Game 1 Silly Impressions

Who can do the best impression?

- → Hop like a bunny
- > Peck like a chicken
- Swim like a duck
- Leap like a goat
- → Lay like a lamb

Game 2 Virtual Easter Egg Hunt

Hide eggs in one part of your room and take a photo. Share the image and ask children to annotate when they spot the eggs.

Game 3 Easter-Themed Pictionary

A drawer sketches an Easter word or phrase and everyone guesses.

Some ideas: egg hunt, springtime, a hopping bunny, chick, Easter card, lamb, chocolate, sunrise ...

Children could come up with their own ideas too.

Game 4 Easter Egg Juggle

How many eggs can you juggle? Try one. Add another ... And another ...

Ask: Why is Easter Sunday a day of celebration?

Sing It

Discuss

- → What do you notice about the story?
- → Do you have any questions?

Read Matthew 28:1-10.

Discuss:

- → I wonder what it was like for Mary going to Jesus' tomb that morning?
- → I wonder how Mary felt when she saw Jesus' body was not in the tomb?
- → I wonder what it was like to hear the words, 'Jesus is alive. Jesus is risen'?
- → I wonder what it felt like to tell others that Jesus is risen?
- → I wonder how we can know that Jesus is alive?

Action It

- Say: Jesus is alive! He defeated death. He destroyed sin so we can be in relationship with God. Do you believe Jesus died for you and rose from the dead? Do you put your trust in him?
- Say: We celebrate that we serve a living God today. But there are so many people who won't celebrate Easter, who don't know Jesus died for us and rose again. Let's talk about who these people might be, and how we can tell them.

Ask: What are the hard questions people might ask you? How do you answer?

Role play how different conversations might go with your friends. What could you say? How might different friends respond?
