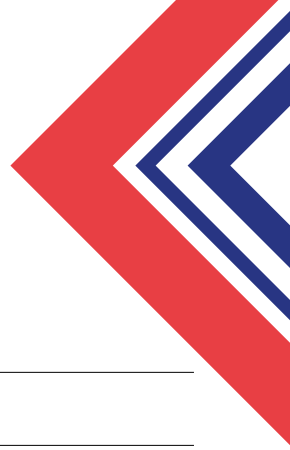


# SPONSORSHIP AND GIFT AID MATERIALS FORM

If I have ticked the box headed 'Gift Aid? (tick)', I confirm that I am a UK taxpayer. I have read this statement and want The Salvation Army to reclaim tax on the donation detailed below, given on the date shown. I understand that I must pay an amount of Income Tax and/or Capital Gains in the tax year than the amount of Gift Aid claimed on all of my donations, and it is my responsibility to pay any difference. I understand the charity will reclaim 25p of tax on every £1 that I have given.

We are sometimes unable to claim Gift Aid on donations made by relatives. Please tick the 'relative box' if you are connected\* through blood or marriage. You do not need to tick if you are a nephew, niece, uncle, aunt or cousin.

## Remember:

**Full name + Home address (not work address) + Postcode + Amount + Date Paid + (tick) = *giftaid it* for the charity to claim tax back on your donation.**

If the sponsor is connected to the participant, their donations only qualify for Gift Aid if the participant pays the full cost of their involvement in the event so that all sponsorship money raised goes to the charity.
