## Draw

On the other side write all the things that could happen if things went well if she trusted God's plan – (which they did!)

Using a sheet of paper, draw round a cup in the middle, then around a bowl, then around a plate so you have three circles with the smaller inside the bigger.

- In the middle write your name.
- In the next circle write the names and places where you meet and go to regularly.
- In the big circle write the names and places you go to sometimes.
- Pray to be God's influence in these areas.
