Here are some ideas and activities you could do as a family

Dance

Time for a workout! Find someone at home who would love to dance with you and have a go at learning the moves to this week's song.

Tell

In these sessions we have been learning about sharing the good news of Jesus with others. After the first session you may have had a chat with someone at home about what they find easy or difficult about sharing their faith. Have a catch-up with them and discuss whether you've had the opportunity to share your faith with someone. If not, pray together and ask God to put someone in your path whom you can tell about Jesus.



Create

Blind people use a system of raised dots to help them read.

Braille Alphabet Card

Try writing Braille by planning out the dots on paper. Then turn the paper over and use a sharpish pencil to push up the dots to make Braille letters.

Use the Braille alphabet to write a message to someone in your family about how much Jesus loves them.

Show them the alphabet card so that they can work out what your message says: 'The good news of Jesus is for everyone.'



Discover

Our character in this week's story is blind and isn't treated very well by those around him. One way of loving others is to try and understand how they experience the world. Watch the clip with someone from home and discover together what it is like to be sight impaired or blind.
