- Take photos of what you've been doing so we can share them on our Facebook page.



Spot the woodland homes

How many different homes can you find on your walk? Here are some you could look out for:



Nature craft: mini-den

Make a mini-den for one of your toy friends. Collect six to ten long sticks from the ground, about 30cm long. Make them into a tepee shape and tie some string around the top. Add more string, leaves, flowers and feathers to make it cosy and colourful! Don't forget to share a photo of your finished den on our Facebook page.



Craft: paper bag house

Turn your paper bag into a house! Use the shapes and stickers in your pack to add a door, windows, roof and decorations. You'll find glue and wooden spreaders in your bag today. When you've finished, please pop the glue pot in our recycling box, or take it home and reuse it.
