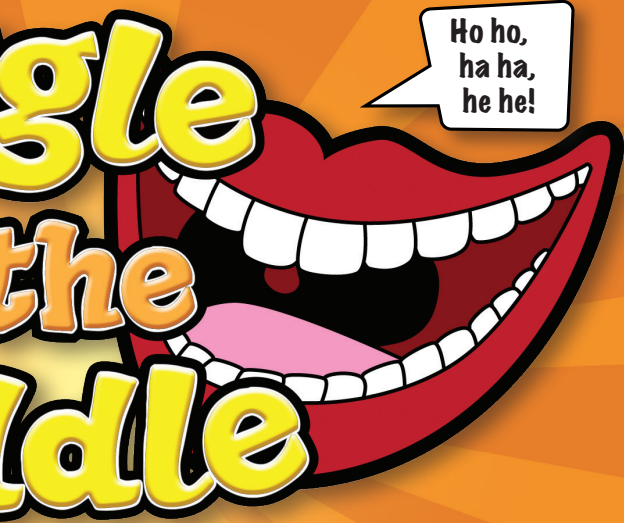

Because they're sole mates!

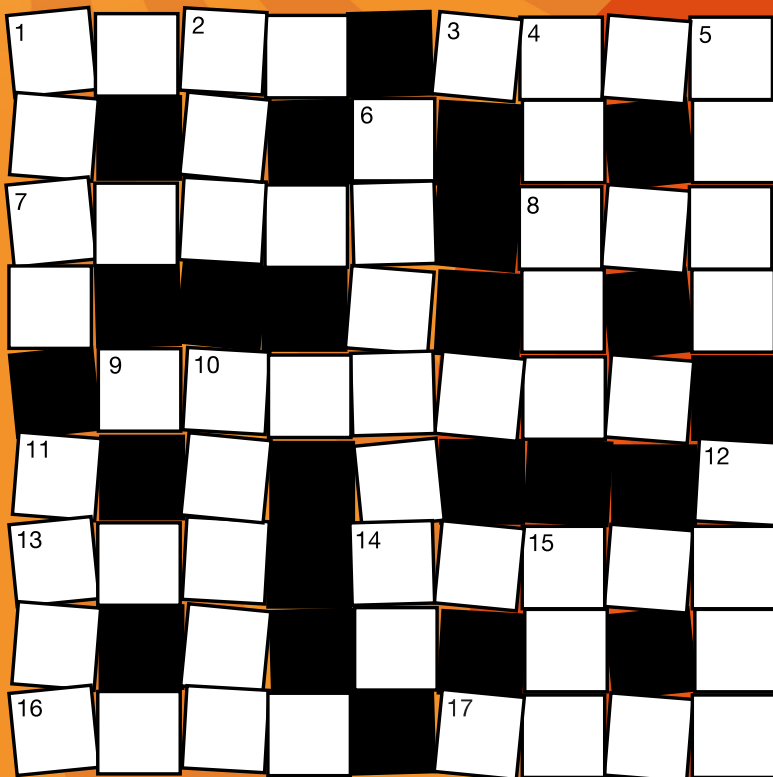
