Share a child-friendly version of Psalm 23:5-6 (eg Biblegateway.com *ERV/EASY*).

Sit in a circle and ask the group to share together:

- Have you ever had a big meal? What was it? Who was there?
- The Bible says that God provides everything we need, just like someone prepares a lovely big meal for their visitors. What food would you choose to eat at a big meal?

- Have you been to a restaurant where you or your grown-up had a refillable drink?
 What happens? Do you run out of drink?
- The Bible says that God's goodness never runs out! What do you think that means?
 What does that make you think about?

Games and activities to reinforce the Bible passage:

- Create a welcome banner that can be displayed in your room/building
- Use modelling clay / play-dough to create a feast, then practise welcoming each other!
- Play a whispering game. Sit in a circle and send a message around, eg 'God welcomes everyone!' or 'God is always with me'.
- Play a relay race. Two teams compete to see who can fill their cup - with water the fastest!
