



The first Wimbledon

I was born in Ontario, Canada but grew up in Bromley, England.

My father is from Romania and my mother is from China.
I was a wildcard entry to Wimbledon in 2021. I had been ranked outside the top 300, but successfully reached the 4th round!

Later that year, I became the first British woman since 1977 to win a Grand Slam when I won the US Open without losing a single set.
