What is Core Recovery?


Core Recovery is the Salvation Army's Recovery Church.

A Recovery Church is a community which is there to support people in growing a meaningful spiritual experience that impacts their life and their recovery; whether that recovery is from addictive substances, health or life situations.

How does it do this?

It does this by:

- Working to a set of values, including: inclusion & belonging, a spirit of equality, and an expectation of transformation. These are outlined in Core Recovery's 8 principles and are understood by each community.
- Emphasising & reimagining certain elements of church. Hospitality is central, woven through everything that takes place, interactive discipleship that focuses on life issues, and the development of honest relationships that can support and celebrate as appropriate. Core Recovery has a meeting outline that gives space for all these elements and is adaptable to most settings.
- Understanding how to develop an enabling environment conducive to recovery, including empowering relationships and safe spaces. Core Recovery will provide training and support to help each community gain confidence in these areas.

IMPORTANCE OF STORY

Core Recovery encourages people to share their journey in an honest way. The integrity of the community is promoted by focussing on the changes that we ourselves want to make. When somebody is sharing we listen respectfully valuing their views and opinions.

HEALING SPACE

Core Recovery is an environment which promotes well-being, it is safe, encouraging, peaceful, calm and hassle free.

Core Recovery leadership is defined by empathy and compassion. Training and support will be given in key areas of addiction, mental health and the principles of Core Recovery as a fresh expression of Church.
