Domestic abuse is one of the most devastating challenges to family life. It involves incidents or patterns of controlling, threatening, degrading and/or violent behaviour, including sexual, psychological, financial, online abuse or harassment. It is usually perpetrated by a partner or ex-partner, though UKI legislation also recognises abuse by family members or carers.

Scripture calls Christians to stand with those who are oppressed and to join in with God's work of restoration. Listening without judgement, respecting a survivor's decisions and offering to walk alongside them can be gentle yet powerful ways of showing love and care.
