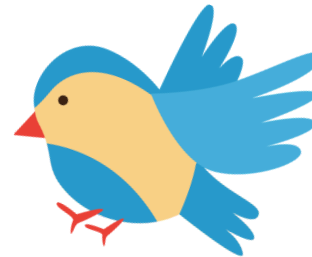
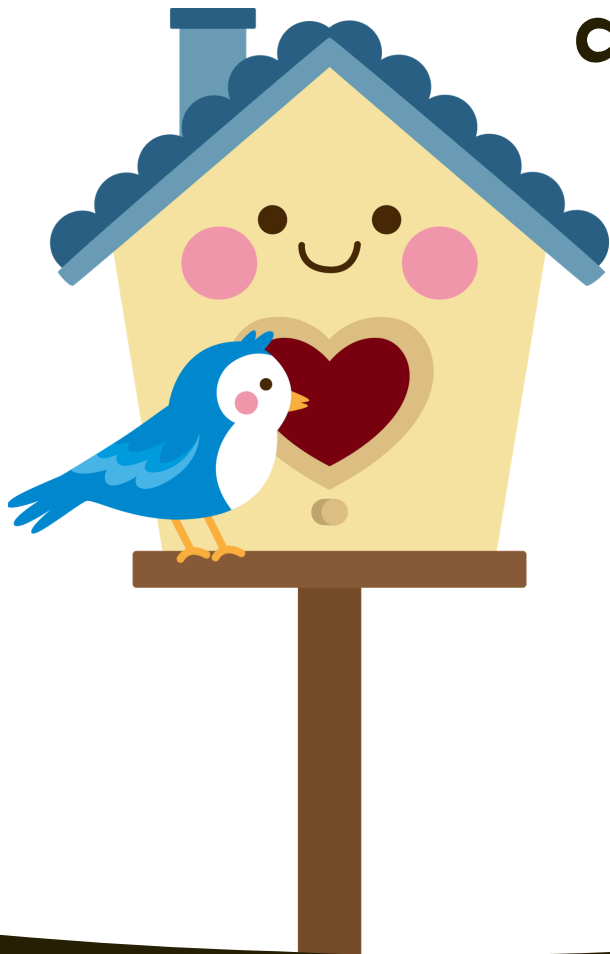


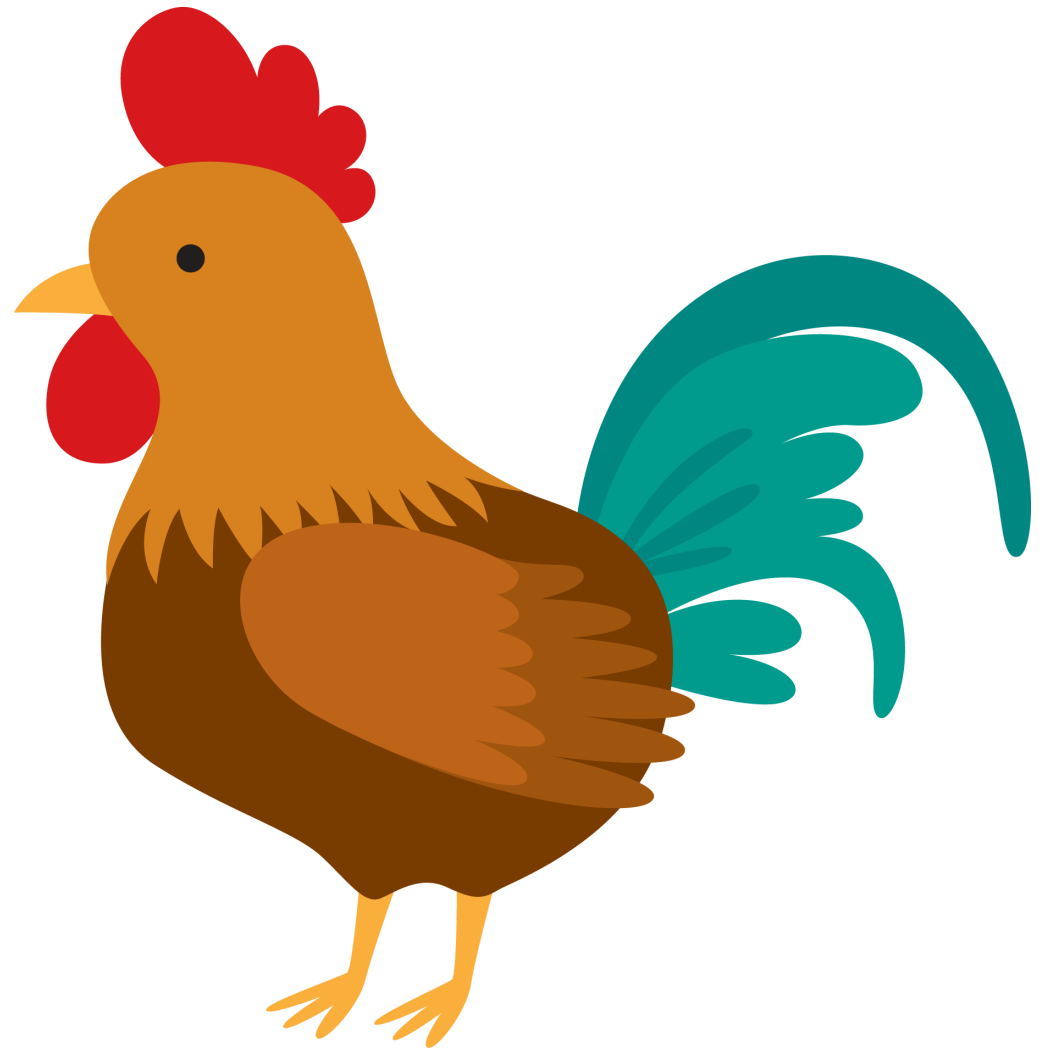

taller than people!**



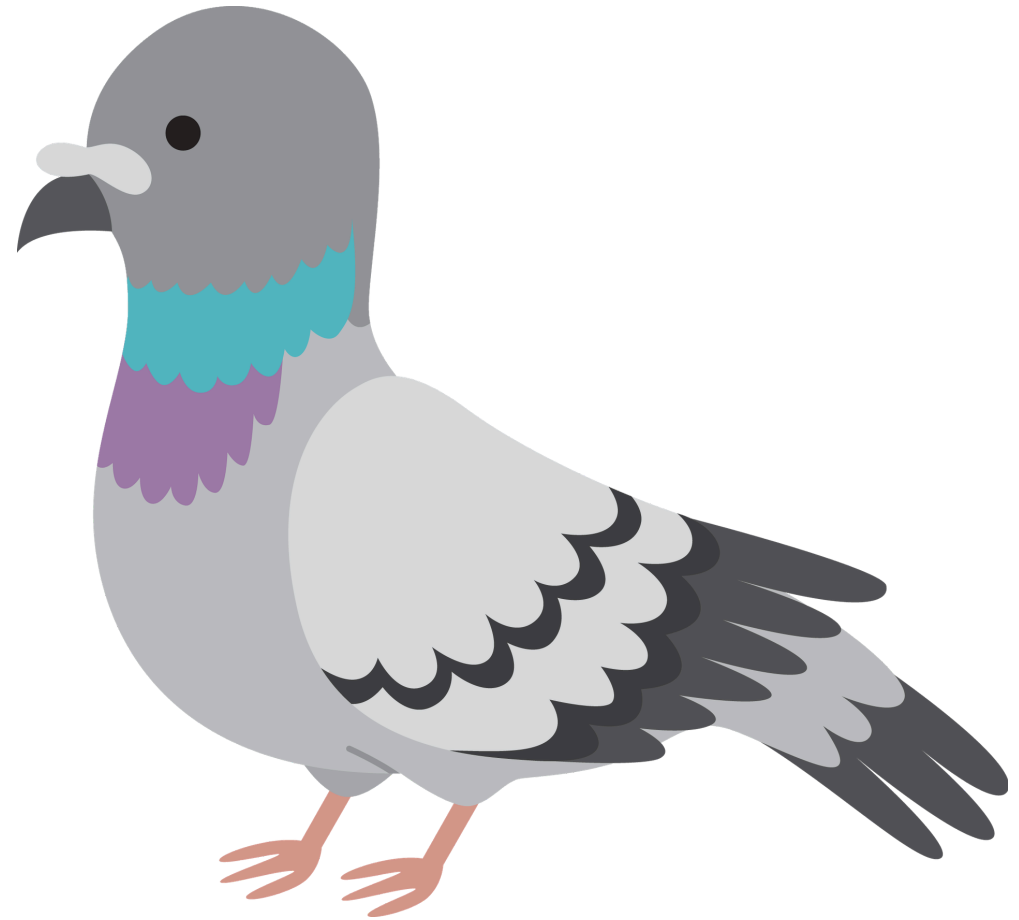
Be a noisy parrot!

for a walk.

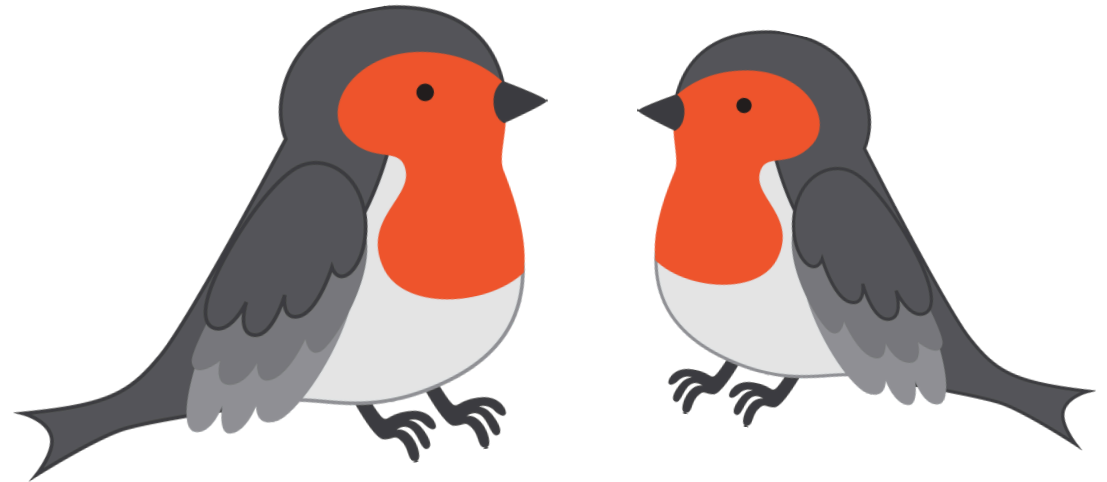
Pigeons have good

beaks to find food.



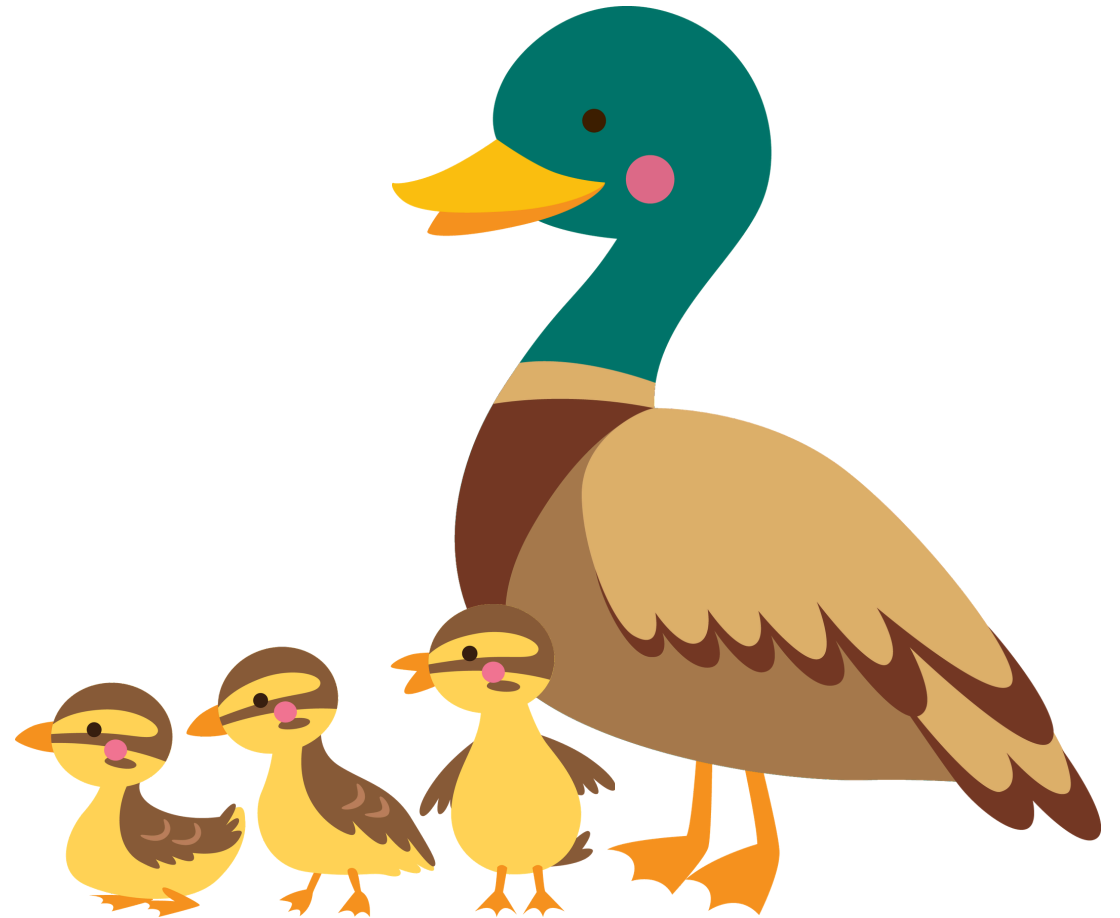
**Stretch up your neck

slowly turn white.**



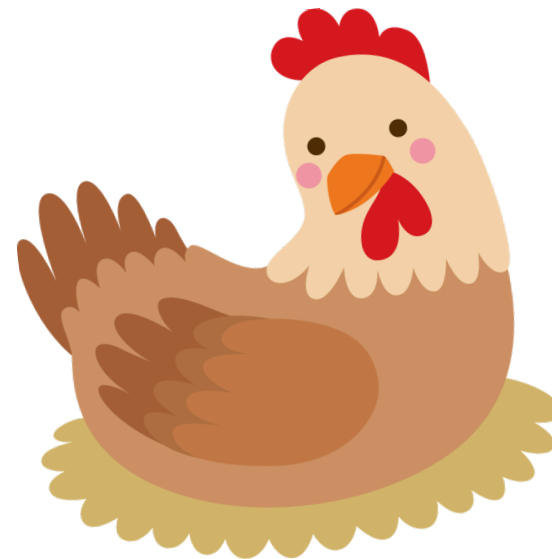
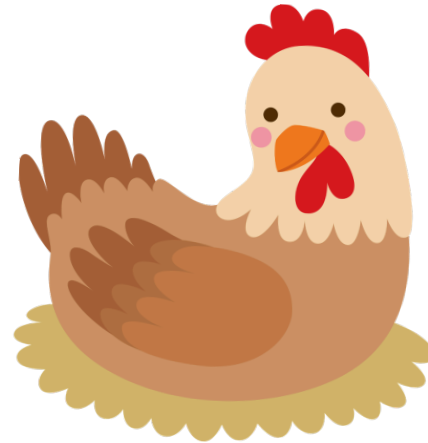
